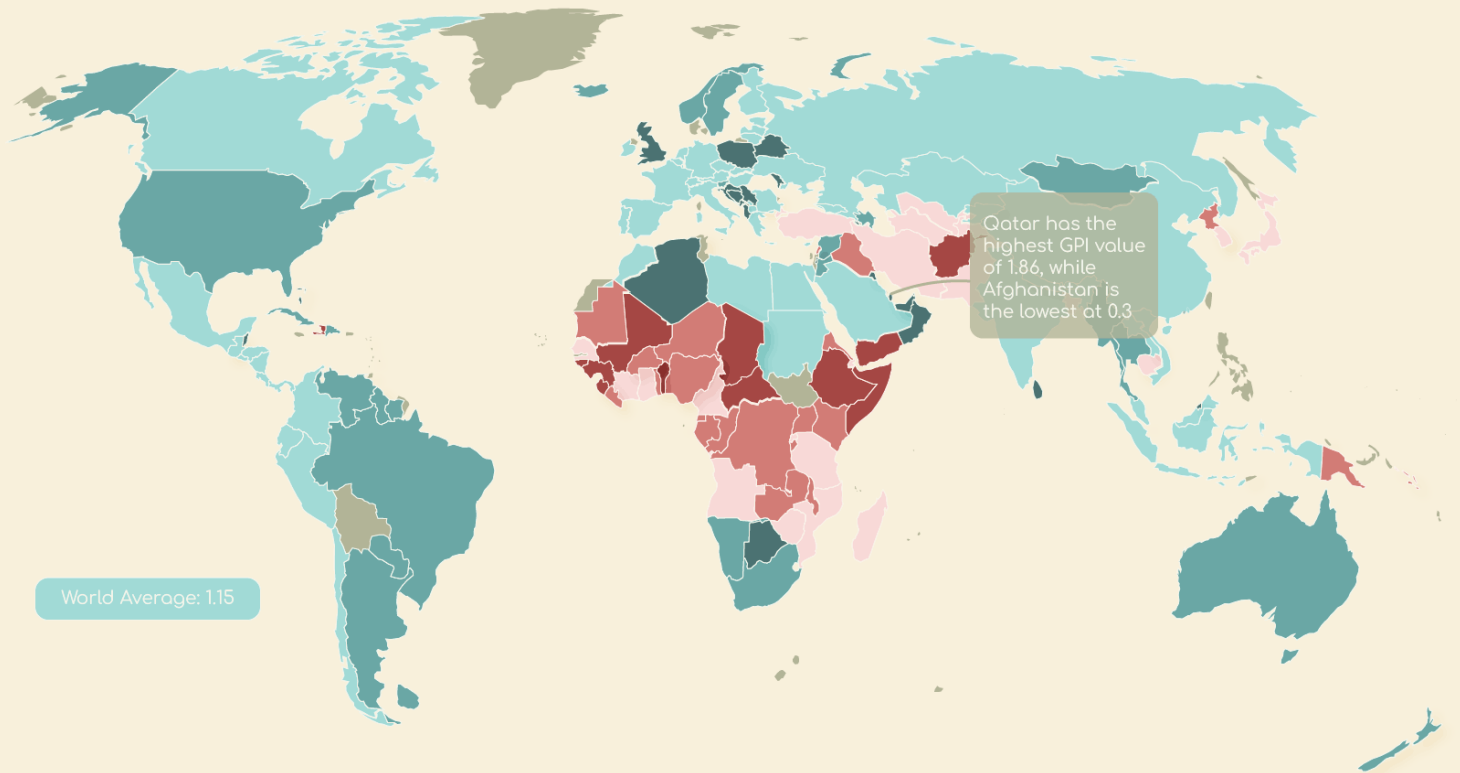
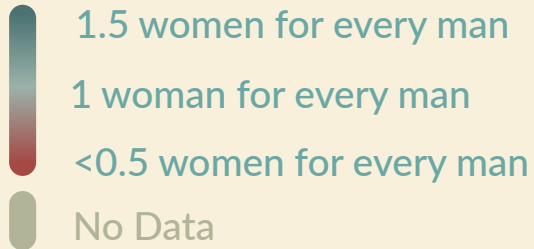

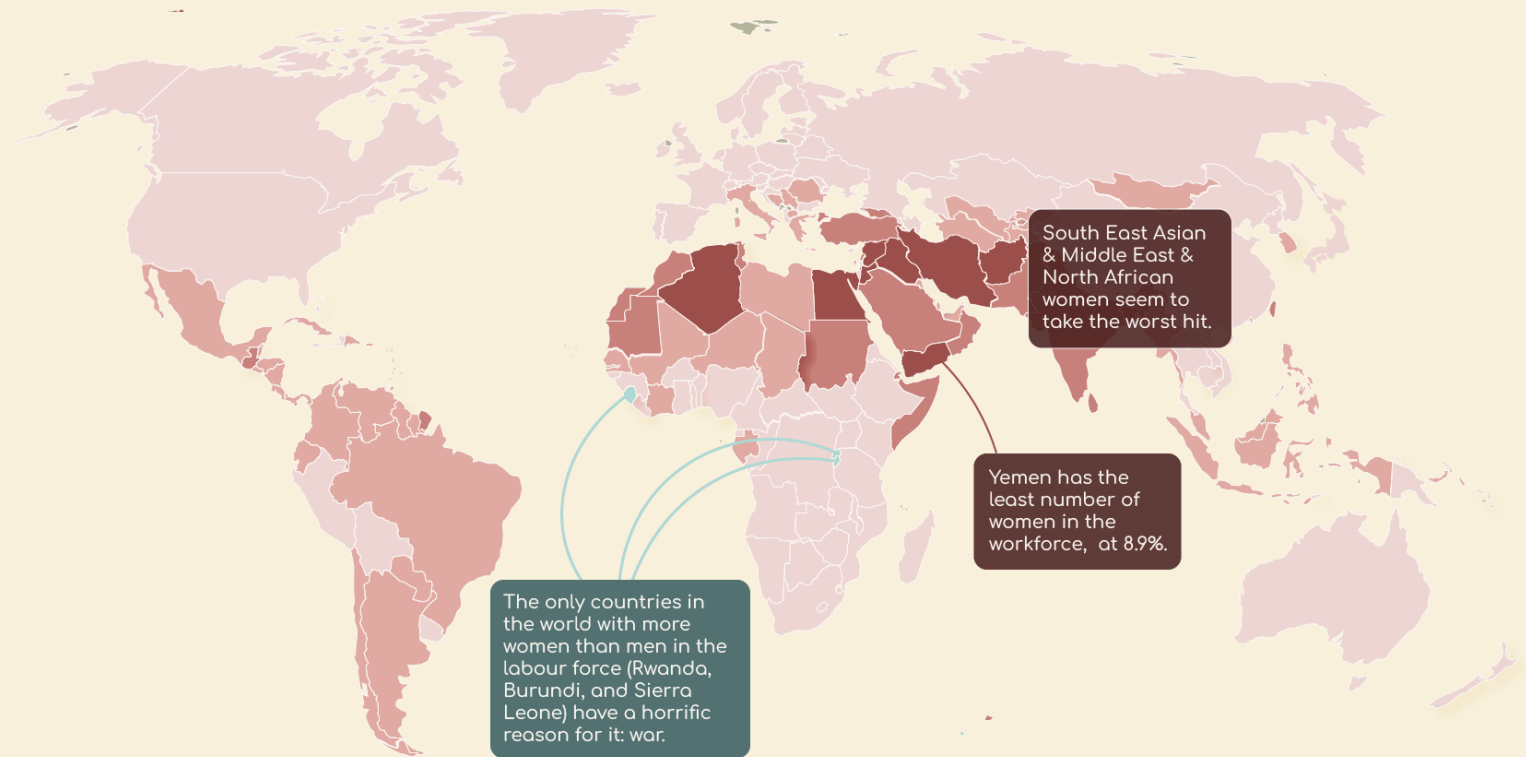
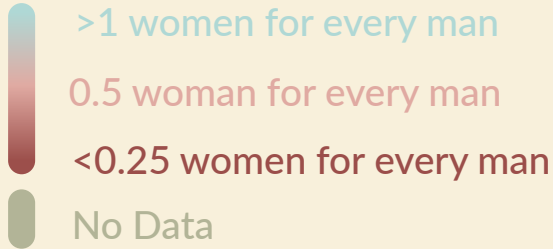
# Women seem to have the upper hand when it comes to completing their tertiary education
